



THE CONTINUUM OF CARE

HOUSE CALLS

Home-Based Primary Care program for patients with mobility issues or chronic illnesses that prevent them from visiting a doctor's office.

CAREGIVER SOLUTIONS

Professional caregivers assist patients with tasks for daily living. Available to patients at any point on their care journey.

PALLIATIVE CARE

Supportive care for patients living with serious illness. Can be provided with curative treatments.

HOSPICE CARE

Compassionate end-of-life care for patients who no longer pursue curative treatments but wish to increase comfort and quality of life. Carolina Caring operates 3 hospice houses.

BEREAVEMENT

Counseling services and support groups provided at no cost to families of hospice patients for up to 13 months following a death.



Pediatric palliative and hospice care program helping children and families experience joy despite the child's serious illness. Palliative, hospice, and prenatal services may run concurrent with curative treatments.

SPECIALIZED CARE PROGRAMS

Advanced Cardiac Care: Specialized care that addresses and helps patients manage the symptoms of advanced heart disease.

Advanced Lung Care: Specialized support that addresses and helps patients manage chronic or progressive lung conditions.

Dementia Care: Specialized program to help ease the burdens and symptoms of dementia for patients and their families.
